The determination to establish a materials charge must consider the fact that funds are allocated for instructional supplies in the General Fund budget and are intended to cover the basic requirements in a course. For example, if a film is necessary for a course, instructional supplies and services funds should be made available for its rental.

Instructional materials that are charged to the student must have a personal benefit in addition to academic value. Personal benefit means that the student receives a finished, tangible product of some intrinsic value (a value external to the course itself). **The student may be charged only for the actual or pro rata cost of the materials involved. The student must have the option of obtaining the materials necessary from any source (i.e., the SFSU Bookstore) as long as the materials meet the instructional requirements.**
